Romans 8:15

2. **Bind the Spirit that blinds their eyes.**

3. **Release to them the Spirit of Adoption (Sonship)**

Romans 8:18 “For you did not receive a spirit that makes you a slave again to fear, but you received the Spirit of sonships. And by Him we cry, Abba Father.”

Revelation 22:17 “The Spirit and the bride say, Come!”

4. **Pray for believers to enter into good relationships with them.**

Matthew 9:38 “Ask the Lord to send out Labourers into his harvest field.”

5. **Release the spirit of wisdom and revelation on them so they may know God better.**

Ephesians 1:17 “I keep asking that the God of our Lord Jesus Christ, the glorious Father, may give you the spirit of wisdom and revelation, so that you may know hm better,
